The Scholarship is in the form of 1 conference registration and a payment of up to AUD\$600 for the recipient. Half the cash payment will be made to the recipient in advance, the second half of the cash payment will be made once the ACA Foundation Limited has received proof of conference related expenses greater than AUD\$300 and received a 250 word conference report.

1	Applicant must be a member or employed by an ACA Corporate member of the Australasian Corrosion Association Inc.	
2	Applicant is a citizen or permanent resident of Australia or New Zealand.	
3	If requested, applicant must provide a copy of their birth certificate or proof of residency/citizenship.	
4	The <u>ACA Foundation Scholarship Application Form</u> must be completed and submitted to the ACA Foundation by the deadline, including the following details: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Name & Contact Details • Company/Institution Details • Academic, conference/courses and work histories • 200 word outline in support of the application • Letter of support from company/institution • 2 referees 	
5	Scholarship recipients will be required to submit a 250 word report on the Conference and may be requested to provide a short presentation to their local ACA Branch.	
6	Applications for an ACA Foundation Limited Scholarship are made directly to this email address - scholarship@corrosion.com.au	
7	Scholarships are only awarded in response to applications. If the judging panel believes that the applications are not of a high standard then no Scholarship will be awarded for this year.	
8	The applicant must demonstrate that their employer or educational institution will support their application and their participation in the Scholarship.	
10	The ACA Foundation Limited Scholarship judging panel will be determined by the ACA Foundation Limited Board.	
11	The Scholarship judges reserve the right to request a brief presentation via teleconference with short-listed applicants.	
12	The ACA Foundation Limited Judging Panel's decision is final.	
13	The Scholarship shall be judged upon the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ability to present a clear and concise case • Referee's comments ACA Foundation's focus on access, equity and participation
